To join most lineage societies you need at least three proofs for each ancestor:

- a. Birth records
- b. Marriage records
- c. Death records

How we can help you in your research:

- 1. Check newspaper clippings and info that we keep in the CCGS family files for obituaries, births, weddings, plus info other family members have added
- 2. Check our Hinshaw Quaker Records (accepted as primary source evidence)
- 3. History books of Clinton County and surrounding counties
- 4. Family history books
- 5. Book of Marriages in Clinton County
- 6. Indentured Servants in Clinton County
- 7. Children's Home records
- 8. Infirmary records
- 9. Old atlases of Clinton County
- 10. Census notebooks for Clinton County, 1820 1930
- 11.Wills
- 12. Testamentary records (when people died without a will)

13. Tax records

- 14. Deeds
- 15. Probate Court "papers"
- 16. Common Pleas Court: type of case/record
- 17. Clinton County newspaper abstracts
- 18. Chancery records (early court records)
- 19. Land grants (such as Virginia Military District)
- 20. Ohio Roster of Civil War soldiers
- 21. Check to see if anyone has joined a lineage society in Clinton County with your ancestor.
- 22. Check to see who is researching your ancestors besides YOU. We have records of their visits.
- 23. Ask genealogy volunteers for help.
